

MARGINALIZATION AND THE PROVISION OF BASIC EDUCATION IN KENYA'S URBAN INFORMAL SETTLEMENTS



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Abstract

While the Kenyan government has and continues to make efforts to provide Quality Basic Education for slum Children, just like for any Kenyan child, the ways in which it has done this, mainly through policy, still exhibit, and sometimes, promote disparities that tend to marginalize the children even further, compared to their counterparts in public schools. This presentation examines the dynamics of educational policies in informal settlements in Kenya, particularly how they are, partly, the push factors that force the urban poor children out of public education to utilize the alleged “low-cost” private education despite the existence of FPE policy.
