Learning for All Children: Challenges for the Post 2015 Education



Speaker: Dr. Bob Prouty

Dr Bob Prouty is an outstanding expert in education development in developing countries. Dr. Prouty was Lead Education Specialist at the World Bank, and until February 2013, he was the Head of the Global Partnership for Education. Presently he is a visiting professor at GSICS, Kobe University.

Dr. Prouty specializes in classroom issues and learning outcomes, education of children from marginalized and vulnerable groups, and aid effectiveness. He holds a Ph. D. in Educational Administration with an emphasis on African studies from Michigan State University and has taught at the primary, secondary, and university levels. Bob lived for 10 years in rural areas of D.R. Congo (formerly Zaire) and Rwanda and speaks three African languages. Much of his career has been focused on education issues in francophone West Africa.
