## KNOWLEDGE ECONOMY AND EDUCATION DEVELOPMENT IN EAST ASIAN DEVELOPING COUNTRIES

### 東アジアの途上国における知識経済と教育開発



#### Abstract

The ability to create, access and apply knowledge is becoming a fundamental determinant of global competitiveness. Innovation policies are critical to the ability of countries to compete and grow in a globalized environment. New models of knowledge production, access and distribution are emerging (e.g., open source, knowledge communities, MOOCs --Massive open online courses like Coursera and Udacity) and we all can use them. In addition, shift to knowledge-intensive industries highlight the importance of well-trained talents. Finally, technological connectivity is transforming the way government, business, and citizens interact.

All these will require adjusting education and learning systems for the Knowledge Economy by (i) addressing first generation challenges: access, equity, and quality (ECD, basic education, minimum institutional setting); (ii) addressing second and third generation challenges; (iii) adjusting teaching and learning environments to respond to new competency requirements; (iv) expanding opportunities and building competencies in secondary and tertiary education with quality; (v) strengthening vocational and firm-based education and training in a cost-effective way; and (vi) adopting comprehensive lifelong learning policies.

During the lecture we will discuss how to go about this.
