Dr. Yuko Harayama received her Ph.D. in Education Science in 1996 and a Ph.D. in Economics in 1997, both from the University of Geneva. Dr. Harayama has a broad range of experience that encompasses work as an Assistant Professor in the Department of Political Economy at the University of Geneva, a Fellow at the Research Institute of Economy, Trade and Industry in Japan and a Member of the Council for Science and Technology Policy (CSTP). Since 2002, she serves as a Professor in the Management of Science and Technology Department at the Graduate School of Engineering of Tohoku University. Her research interests include technology policies, innovation systems, cluster policy, and higher education system.

She served as a member of Council for Science and Technology Policy (CSTP), Cabinet Office, Japan from 2006 to 2008, Deputy Director of the Directorate for Science, Technology and Innovation, OECD from 2010 to 2012, and as Executive Member of Council for Science and Technology Policy (CSTP), Cabinet Office, Japan from 2013 to 2018. Received the French National Order of the Legion of Honour – Chevalier (*Ordre national de la Légion d'honneur - Chevalier*) in 2011.
